In the main bedroom (this picture) the canopy of the Chippendale-design bed from Partridge Fine Arts is lined with silk by Henry Bertrand; the back panel is an eighteenth-century English 'Tree of Life' embroidery. The eighteenth-century French marble chimneypiece (below left) was installed by Alvisé and the panel above is an eighteenth-century silk hanging; the walls are covered with eighteenth-century Chinese silk. Mûré silk lines the walls of the main bathroom (below right); the antique copper bath was supplied by The Water Monopoly
