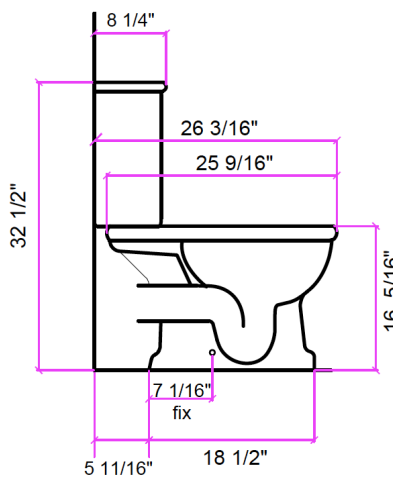


PARIS LAVATORY PAN WITH CLOSE COUPLED CISTERN - US

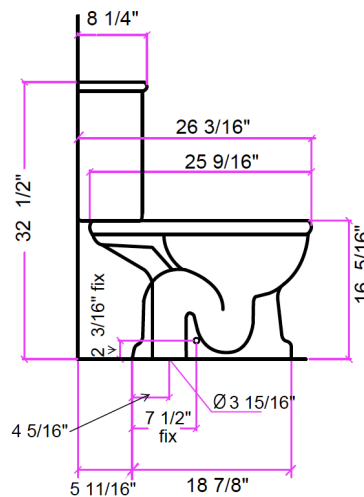
The Paris lavatory pan goes very well with the original French basins with softer detailing. It is also available to use with a low level, high level or concealed cistern and is available as an S or P-trap.



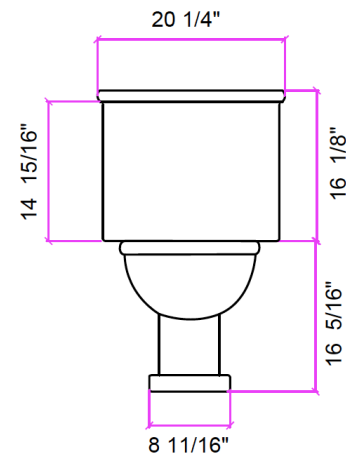
Side view with p-trap pan



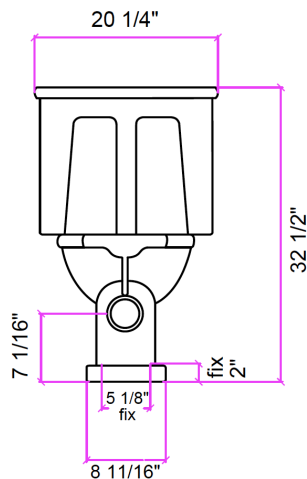
Side view with s-trap pan



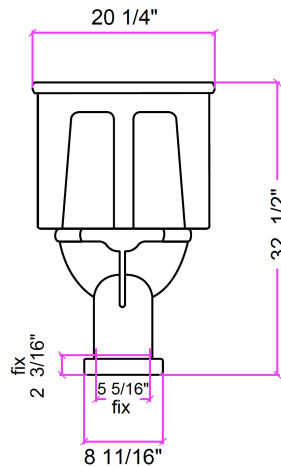
Front view of p and s-trap pans



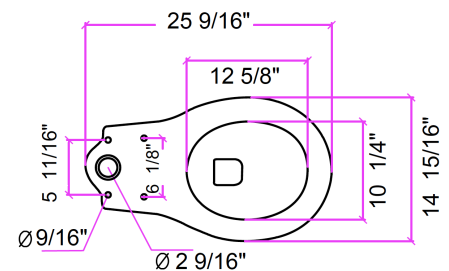
Back view with p-trap pan

Ariel view of p and s-trap pans

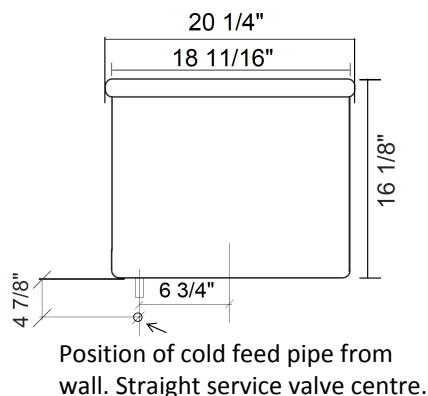

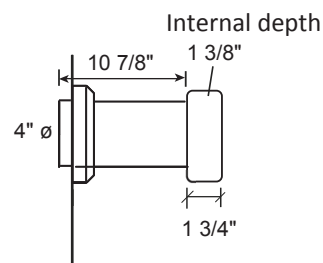

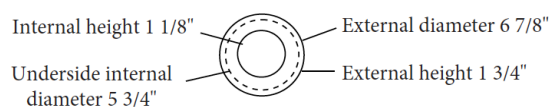
Cistern inlet pipe position diagram

Horizontal pan connector



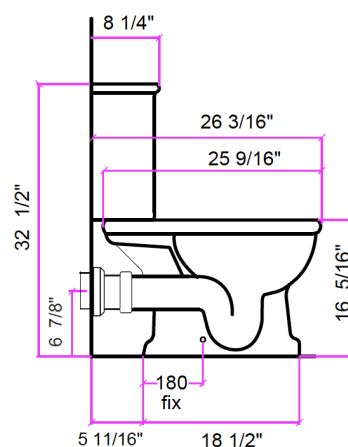
Collar for horizontal pan connector



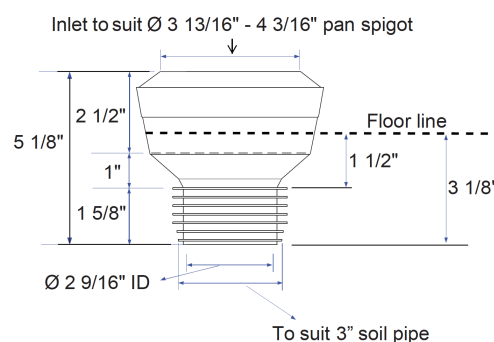
